Overview

The **Midwest Chapter/MLA “Free Lunch” Award** covers the ticket cost for two Chapter members per year to attend the Chapter Council Roundtables Luncheon at the MLA Annual Meeting. This popular event, sponsored by the MLA Chapter Council, gives participants the opportunity to network, share experiences, and engage in informal discussions on a variety of current topics relevant to health sciences librarians.

The 2017 Chapter Council Roundtables Luncheon is set for **Sunday, May 28** from noon-2:00 p.m. at Dream Dare Do: MLA 2017, Seattle, WA. Tickets are \$40. A boxed lunch will be served. Participants must sign up in advance and select a topic when registering for the MLA meeting. Applicant Criteria

Applicants must be:

- A member of the Midwest Chapter/MLA.
- Registered for (or in the process of registering for) the 2017 Roundtables event.

Application Requirements

Applications must include:

- Applicant's name, mailing address, and e-mail address or phone number.
- Roundtable discussion topic in which applicant will be participating.
- A paragraph or two describing “Why I deserve a free lunch.”

Selection Process

The Midwest Chapter/MLA Awards and Scholarships Committee will evaluate all applications on the basis of conciseness, creativity, humor, pathos and/or neediness. (Criteria are flexible!) Recipients will be notified by **March 28, 2017**, and receive subsequent reimbursement from the Chapter for their pre-paid tickets.
