Nomination Criteria

Nominees must be:

- Members of the Midwest Chapter at the time of nomination and for at least 3 years prior.
- Nominated by a Midwest Chapter member.

Nomination Requirements

Nominations must be received by **August 4, 2017**, and must include:

- A completed nomination form. See <http://midwestmla.org/committees/awards/>.
- A current resume or vitae of the nominee.
- A letter of nomination stating why the nominee should be recognized and what specific accomplishments and achievements are pertinent.
- Two additional letters of support, at least one from someone who is not employed at the nominee's institution.

Selection Process

The Midwest Chapter/MLA Awards and Scholarships Committee will select the winner based solely on evaluation of the nomination materials received. Criteria used to evaluate nominees on meaningful and measurable service to the Chapter may include but not necessarily be limited to: leadership, advocacy, scholarship, research, publications, presentations, teaching, training, mentoring, outreach, and professional activities.

The Committee reserves the right not to select any winner if no nominees meet the requirements or none are deemed qualified.
